

Informations about baptism certification before 01 september 1871 (for the law requirements)

In Treviso dioceses, baptism certifications have to be requested directly at the parish, for only there the original historical record is kept.

The Historical Diocesan Archives is able to help those who are seeking this kind of certificates: just send a request via e-mail at certificati@diocesiv.it (as specified in the attachment n° 1) indicating:

- name and family name to look for (and possible variations occurred in the past generations)
- date of birth or range of possibility
- place of birth (you're required to specify location and district as well)
- a copy of the applicant's id must be attached

The certificate must be signed by the priest and his signature has to be validated by the chancellery of the Diocesan Authority.

A tax of 50€, chancellery fee included, must be paid to the parish for the certificate to be issued, following the instructions released by the same parish.

Further informations:

1 - Since 01-09-1871 the civil registry started its effectiveness, therefore all certificates subsequent to that date must be requested directly to the civil registry of the city of birth

2 - If you don't know exactly the parish, the Historical Archives of the Diocese can actualize a research inside the registry of Confirmations, in order to unveil the parish (attachment n° 2).

Registry of Confirmation validity is only for the years 1862 to 1918.

This search, also with negative output, needs a 50€ payment to the Iban code which will be communicated to you via email

3- Some parishes' records have been destroyed during the wars; you have to make out what kind of alternative certification is required by the Consulate for the identification of citizenship. Check attachment n° 3
